Instruction for Effective Study at Home (Grade II)

Students are advised to follow subject wise instructions for active and effective study at home.

English

1. Read one page a day of your textbook. Underline any 5 difficult words. Find their meanings and learn spellings. Make a list, day-wise, of new words learnt.
2. On completing reading of the chapter, try making sentences of your own of 5 naming words, 5 doing words and 5 describing words.

3. Observe the pictures given in your chapters and try speaking 3 to 5 sentences about the picture in your own words.
4. Try Question/ Answers and MCQ's based comprehension from passages of "Faiza's Biscuits", "The Trap", and "The Mice and the Elephant". Any 3 passages from each page of the said chapters must be practised. There must be 2-3 questions asked from content of the selected passage.
5. Select any 5-8 words from all included chapters and make their rhyming words.
6. Try writing 8-12 sentences composition writings based on "Animals" on practice sheets in both English and Urdu.
7. Learn grammatical concepts from linked videos and try solving Grammar Skills pages for concept practice. The grammatical concepts must be identified on students reading books as well.
8. Learn poems included in first term syllabus of Urdu.
9. Try model writing pages for improving your cursive hand writing pattern.

Mathematics

1. Watch linked videos and practice all mentioned questions.
2. Learn and practice one topic for 3 days at least for better learning.
3. The topics learnt in a week must be reinforced through quick assessment by parents in the next week, preferably on Monday.

Social Science

1. Read one chapter a week.
2. Solve the exercises by taking guideline from teaching material.
3. Learn the exercises with special focus on spellings.

Islamiat

1. Read the chapters.
2. Learn Q/A's of all first term units from workbook.

Quran

1. Learn Nazra daily (5 ayats).
2. Learn Surah's with translation.
3. Learn Duas.

Computer

1. Watch linked videos and practice all mentioned practicals.
2. Learn worksheets of all units.
