Instruction for Effective Study at Home (Grade III-VIII)

The Punjab School-DRC/JTC has planned some assignments for its students so that they can make the optimum use of their time and energy. The links have been provided with the topics for quick reference.

Adopt paper presentation skills while practicing at home.

Follow subject wise instructions for active and effective study at home.

English/Urdu

Utilize 2 days for Reading book and 3 days for Grammar. 1 day must be assigned for Composition writing skills enhancement.

- Read at least two pages of your English and Urdu textbooks daily. Underline the difficult words and look for their meanings in dictionary. For English, meanings have to be found in simple English, preferably. Prepare dictation words. After completing reading of the unit, practice making your own sentences of the new words learnt on loose sheets.
- Students must be encouraged for story retelling in their own words in summarized pattern. It would also help for preparing the objective items from text.
- For Poem section, identify the poetic devices used by poet.
- Solve the exercises of reading book units at completion of reading of the chapter (with lead pencil).
- Grammar topics learnt must be solved on Grammar Skills and Urdu workbook respectively. The practice of the topic needs to be done on Essential Skills and from Urdu Grammar book. Definitions have to be learnt thoroughly.
- Watch linked videos for the outlines of letters, stories, applications and essays. The material for writing, however, has to be consulted from provided teaching material.
- Rules for translation from Urdu to English must be learnt properly. It is advised to practice some extra sentences from any English Grammar and Composition book of the relevant level, for better clarity of concepts. This would also prepare the students for unseen translation sentences.
- Practice translation on loose sheets.
- Practice first term grammar concepts of English for Grammarian competition.
- ***Handwriting practice is to be done by students of Grade III-V of at least 3 pages a week to improve their cursive writing pattern in English. Handwriting pages uploaded with the tasks earlier and/or later, can be referred for the exact writing pattern of English and Urdu.***

Mathematics

- Watch linked videos and practise all mentioned questions.
- At least one exercise has to be practised daily (*V-VIII*). ***For grades III & IV, students are advised to learn and practice one concept a day. 2 days must be spent on one concept for better comprehension and application of the topic.***
- Review exercises have to be solved separately at completion of chapter (*V-VIII*). ***For grades III & IV, students must practice their reinforcement worksheets mentioned in their workbooks.***
- The chapters have to be prepared for objective items as well.
- Practise 1st Term chapters for IBN-al-Haythm competition, conceptually.

Science

- Chapter reading is to be done thoroughly. Highlight the important statements for objectives. The objective statements have to be drafted on practice sheets for future reference.
- Solve all included Test Yourself questions consulting the provided teaching material. ***Students of grades III-V are suggested to copy the question/ answers of relevant topics from provided teaching material and learn. New concept/ topic must be started after getting complete grip of both (text and Q/A) of the previous one.***
- Workbooks have to be solved at completion of the chapter.
- The additional information mentioned in Did you Know? / Science facts must not be ignored.
- Learn all Short and Long Questions with headings and subheadings.
- Practice diagrams (making and labeling) of all units on practice sheets.
- The chapters have to be prepared for A.Q. Khan competition, conceptually.

Social Studies

- Chapter reading is to be done thoroughly. Highlight the important statements for objectives. The objective statements have to be drafted on practice sheets for future reference.
- Learn Short and Long Questions with headings and subheadings as mentioned in the teaching material already uploaded.
- Practise labeling of all maps included in the chapters.
- List down all the important events and their relevant dates for learning (History section).

Islamiat

- Chapter reading is to be done thoroughly. Highlight the important statements for objectives. The objective statements have to be drafted on practice sheets for future reference.
- Solve and learn exercises of all units including short and long questions.
- Learn Surah/ Ayat/ Hadith with translation.

Quran

- Recite Quran one or two ruku a day, with correct tajweed. Makharij have to be practiced properly.
- Learn Surah's with translation.
- Masnoon duaain with translation must be recited daily.
- Offer prayers five times a day (keeping in mind its translation for better Khushu o' Khuzu)
- ***Students of grade III-V may make their prayer chart to get regularize in offering all prayers.***

Computer

- Read full chapter and mark the important statements for objective practice.
- All flow charts/ algorithms and other examples given in chapters must be practised (VI-VII).
- Solve and learn the exercises given at the end.
- Practise all practicals.
